

The House Committee on Public Education met yesterday and voted out the Committee Substitute to House Bill 2 (CSHB2) with one amendment on a 6-3 vote.

Voting in favor of CSHB2 were Representatives Kent Grusendorf (R-Arlington), Dan Branch (R-Dallas), Diane White Delisi (R-Temple), Rob Eissler (R-The Woodlands), William Keffer (R-Dallas), and Anna Mowery (R-Fort Worth).

Voting “no” were Representatives Harold Dutton (D-Houston), Scott Hochberg (D-Houston), and Rene Oliviera (D-Brownsville).

Chairman Grusendorf stated that the CSHB2 could be schedule for action on the floor of the House as soon as Monday, March 7.

The amendment added to CSHB2 reworded language in the bill to have the recapture rate limited for 3 years and then it would raise to the 35% cap.
